**EMAILING OF PIPELINE SAFETY INSPECTION NOTICES**

Effective June 1, 2017, the Pipeline Safety department of Railroad Commission of Texas (RRC) will email inspection notices to pipeline operators. In addition, pipeline operators should submit plans of correction to the RRC via email to [safety@rrc.texas.gov](mailto:safety@rrc.texas.gov).

By May 26, 2017, pipeline operators must submit to the RRC the name and email address for the appropriate officer of the company to receive inspection notices. Submit this information via email to [safety@rrc.texas.gov](mailto:safety@rrc.texas.gov).

Should a pipeline operator still need to receive correspondence via U.S. mail, please notify the Pipeline Safety department via email or telephone by May 26, 2017.
